International Selection

As you may be aware, there can be some confusion regarding the difference between Pinot Gris (French) and Pinot Grigio (Italian) Both translate to 'pine shaped and grey'. This doesn't explain a lot, except that the same grape variety is used in both wines, and as we all know, appearances can be deceiving.

To put it simply, Pinot Gris is a French wine that originates in Alsace (where it is also known as Tokay d'Alsace). The Pinot Gris of Alsace is typically summarised as rich and sometimes sweet, medium to full-bodied, with a floral hint and distinct flavours of pears or melon.

Pinot Grigio, the Italian wine originating from the North of Italy shows a lighter, crisp, clean and vibrant expression of the grape with flavours reminiscent of apples and citrus flavours.

For the Delamere Vineyards Naissante example, we are making a wine in the Pinot Gris style, aiming for a rounded, more textured wine, and very much looking for the pear characteristics found in riper versions of this grape. In reality, the acid line of the Naissante Pinot Gris probably places it between the two styles at present, but with time in the bottle, richness will develop further. We believe it is best served with fine food and fabulous friends.

So in honour of a very small volume, we release to you our 2015 Pinot Gris, as well as an Alsace Pinot Gris from Hugel, showing good intensity with aromas of ripe pears, baked apple with spice endnotes. The palate has a good richness and a rounded textural quality featuring flavours of ripe pears and baked apple followed by subtle musk with a spicy medium dry finish (*Note in true French fashion this bottle is cork sealed).

The second international wine is a beautiful Pinot Grigio from Friuli Jermann. It shows pure, clean stone, flint and minerals, with a nose of focused green-pear, exotic ripeness and juicy character, great balance and finesse with an extended finish. We hope you enjoy the battle of the European borders.
